

## **Measures Taken to make campus ragging free**

### **PREAMBLE.**

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of "University of Kerala v/s. Council, Principals, Colleges and others" in SLP no. 24295 of 2006 dated 16.05.2007 and that dated 8.05.2009 in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, and in consideration of the determination of the Central Government and the University Grants Commission to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including, as per the recommendations of **Medical Council of India, New Delhi** based upon directives from **Hon'ble Supreme Court**, which are in turn based on recommendations of **Raghvan Committee**, Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) are required to take appropriate, preventive and corrective steps to make the campus ragging free from the menace of ragging. any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in all the constituents colleges of DMIMS(DU) , and thereby, to provide the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students, the DMIMS (DU) in consultation with deans and administrative authorities of constituent colleges will enforce strict discipline and vigilance.

# Measures Taken to Curb the Menace of Ragging & Action Taken Report

As per the recommendations of **Medical Council of India, New Delhi** based upon directives from **Hon'ble Supreme Court**, which are in turn based on recommendations of **Raghvan Committee**, Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) and per university objective to make the campus ragging free with zero tolerance are required to take appropriate, preventive and corrective steps to make the campus ragging free from the menace of ragging. Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College a constituent college of Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences University has also taken steps in that direction as stated below:

1. **Sensitization of the faculty members:** In view of increasing the level of awareness of the members of faculty including heads of Department, Anti ragging committee and Anti ragging Squad has been reconvened under the chairmanship of Dr.Sandeep Shrivastava, Dean, JNMC in the month of June, 2015. The chairman in his address to the honorable members shall highlight the salient features of the recommendations and binding regulations of Medical Council of India and stress the need to take all necessary precautions and preventive measures so that no untoward incidence directly or indirectly amounting to ragging occurs in the campus. He shall further sensitize the faculty members and heads of departments to be vigilant in this direction.
2. **Sensitization of the Senior Students:** In order to sensitize the senior students they will be addressed by the Dean, Jawaharlal Nehru medical college in phase wise manner and to bring to their notice the relevant statutory provisions and anti-disciplinary measures which can be taken against those who are found to perpetrate, abate, assist or get involved in any sort of physical or mental harassment which also now comes under the purview of the definition of ragging.
3. **Undertaking from Students:** As per binding regulations referred above, an undertaking about non-indulgence in ragging, will be obtained from every student which is duly countersigned by their parents. The institute had taken measures in this direction and the procedure of obtaining such undertaking will be completed by 31st July of , 2015
4. **Certificate** of good character from the head of the earlier institution will obtained at the time of counseling from the fresher's of Ist MBBS
5. **Anti-Ragging Committee & Squad:** At the level of institute an Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad have been constituted as per directives of the Medical Council of India, New Delhi. The committees have been constituted comprising of members of faculty along with representatives of Police, Media and Non-Government Organization and their composition is as under:

**Punishable ingredients of Ragging:-** • Abetment to ragging;

- Criminal conspiracy to rag;
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- Public nuisance created during ragging;
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- Wrongful restraint;
- Wrongful confinement;
- Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences;
- Extortion;
- Criminal trespass;
- Offences against property;
- Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation.

**Agenda Item No.3:** The advertisement for admissions shall clearly mention that ragging is totally banned / prohibited in the Medical College/Institution and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. Inclusion of Anti-Ragging measures, as per guidelines of UGC/ MCI/DCI in all the Admissions brochure including prospectus :- All measures implemented.

**Agenda Item No.4:** Review of Anti-Ragging committees of constituent colleges:- Done.

**Agenda Item No.5:** Review Anti-Ragging Squad before the admissions: -Anti ragging Squad Formed, Squad members are taking surprise rounds in the fresher's Hostels

**Agenda Item No.6:** Provision of separate hostel to newly admitted students of 2016 as per directives of Raghvan committee/ UGC/ MCI / DCI  
Separate hostel for fresher's is provided. male fresher's i.e. "Vivekananda Hostel" and Female fresher's i.e. "Vaishnavi Hostel".

**Agenda Item No.7:** Illumination of all the vulnerable spots in college campus and hostels: Areas identified and preventive measures taken.

**Agenda Item No.8:** The appointment of resident warden for fresher's hostel as per regulation of statutory body/ UGC/MCI / DCI: -Appointed.

**Agenda Item No.12:** Undertaking from the students that he/she is aware of the law regarding prohibition of ragging as well as the punishments, and to the effect that he/she has not been expelled and/or debarred from admission by any institution and that he/she, if found guilty of the offence of ragging and/or abetting ragging, is liable to be punished appropriately:

Undertaking taken at the time of admission

**Agenda Item No.13:** Undertaking from the parents/Guardian:

Undertaking from the Parents/ Guardian taken.

**Agenda Item No.14:** A student seeking admission to hostels shall have to submit additional undertaking:- Undertaking taken.

**Agenda Item No.15:** A database shall be created out of affidavits affirmed by each student and his/her parents/guardians stored electronically, and shall contain the details of each student. The database shall also function as a record of ragging complaints received: -Done as per MCI, UGC guidelines.

**Agenda Item No.16:** The application for admission shall be accompanied by a document in the form of the School Leaving Certificate/transfer certificate/migration certificate/ Character Certificate which at the time of admission.

All the original documents with the said documents and two sets of Xerox copies obtained from the fresher's during admission.

**Agenda Item No.17:** Deans address to students, in fresher's induction program:
