It has been the policy of the University, that every Postgraduate should meet the essential requirement of 4-P to be eligible to appear in the University examination. In order to discourage the students going for publication in non-Scopus/non-Pubmed journals and to ensure quality publications in high impact journals, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University) has approved the facilitatory alternate mechanism as under:

1. Within one month of the submission of PG thesis, the PG student should prepare the manuscript under the guidance of Research Guidance Cell who will guide them pertaining to preparation of manuscript, journal to be selected for sending, manuscript for publication while ensuring enhancement in the quality of manuscript.
2. The manuscript should be sent for publication to the selected journal with the concerned student as the first author and the concerned guide as the 2nd and corresponding author and the student should also furnish an undertaking to the HOD that in case he/she is not available for further processing of the manuscript, in the event of modifications, queries, rejection and re-submission to other journal, he/she shall authorize the concerned guide to do so on his/her behalf.
3. The proof of manuscript submission for publication in an high impact factor/indexed journal along with the compliance of requisite formalities including cross citations as per policy should be construed as fulfilment of 4P model in regards to publication and the student should be permitted to appear for the University examination, on the basis of that such Post Graduate students shall become eligible for DMIMS(DU) research incentive policy on certification by Research Cell.
