

# Second Successful CADAVERIC MULTIPLE ORGAN DONATION in Vidarbha



Acharya Vinoba Bhave Rural Hospital, Sawangi Meghe, Wardha is now leading in cadaveric organ donation in Vidarbha. Within a months period, 2<sup>nd</sup> cadaveric multiple organ retrieval was done successfully at AVBRH Sawangi Meghe on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2017. This time the donor was a brain dead patient, Mr. Purushottam Vasudeorao Gode, 44 yrs, male from Satafali, Tal. Babhulgaon , Dist. Yavatmal who had suffered a road traffic accident and was admitted in Neurosurgery intensive care unit of AVBRH since 9<sup>th</sup> Jan 2017 whose relatives took the bold & emotional decision of organ donation.

As per the zonal transplant co-ordination committee's directives, his heart was allotted to CIIGMA Hospital Aurangabad, but unfortunately ,because of expected time delay it could not be harvested.

His Liver was harvested and taken to Global Hospital, Mumbai by Dr. Somanath Chattopadhyay & team. One kidney was offered to a patient in Orange City Hospital, Nagpur & another to a patient in Care Hospital, Nagpur. Corneas were also harvested by Dr. Sopan Jaiswal & Dr. Rohit Agraval from AVBRH.

The AVBRH undertook the first ever successful cadaveric organ retrieval in Dec 2016.
