"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(General Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 09 to 11 seats granted by Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Wardha in respect of students being trained at J. N. Medical College, Swangi, Wardha be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."
