



I am directed to refer to Medical Council of India's letter dated 07.01.2017 on the subject mentioned above and to convey approval of the Central Government to the recommendation of Medical Council of India for recognition of MS (General Surgery) qualification against increased intake permitted from 10 to 12 seats granted by Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed University), Wardha in respect of students trained at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Swangi (Meghe), Wardha.

- 2. The recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate course.
